

## **Important Information to Know for Your Stay or Your Loved One's Stay**

### **Visitation**

**Detox:** There is no scheduled visitation during your detox stay aside from organized family sessions with your Detox Counselor.

**Residential Rehabilitation Client Visitation:** Sundays | 1:00-3:00

**Family Education:** Open to everyone

Sundays | 12:00 pm-1:00 pm | Community Education Room

All Visitors must present an I.D.

### **Baggage and Toiletries**

Clients are allowed to bring one bag of clothes and necessities. We do not allow tank tops or camisoles. We always search items that are brought to the facility. Limits allowed are:

- 7 pairs of pants (skirts, shorts, etc.)
- 3 pairs of pajamas
- 15 tops (shirts, blouses, hoodies, sweatshirts)
- 1 jacket
- 4 pairs of footwear (shoes, sneakers, boots, shower shoes)
- 1 set of bed linen including 1 pillow
- Unlimited undergarments

No additional clothing will be permitted beyond this list. No additional clothing will be accepted during Sunday visits.

**No aerosol items or items containing alcohol, food, or drinks from the outside are allowed.**

## **Family and Visiting Children**

Each client will be able to have a maximum of 4 visitors approved. A visitor list is filled out upon admission with our assessor counselor. We ask that only family and significant others visit along with children. All children ages 16 and under count as 1 guest (For example, if you have 5 children, they would only count as 1 guest). We do not encourage visits from friends unless it is someone in your primary support system or a sponsor. Children ages 10 and under may visit with their parent during family education. **Children may never be dropped off and left.**

**If there is a family emergency, the client can request a phone pass from their counselor.**

Family education occurs every Sunday from 12:00 pm-1:00 pm in our community room. It is a 4-5 week series designed to assist family and friends cope with the chemically-addicted loved ones.

All visitors will check in either entering family education or at the reception desk prior to visits. Visits do not begin until 1:00 pm.

All items brought in, such as cigarettes, must be checked with staff first.

All visitors must remain in the designated visiting area. We do not allow visitors on our second level.

All clients are to remain in designated areas; they are not allowed in the driveways or vehicles.

Light refreshments are provided during visits.

Cell phones are not allowed in our facility. All visitors are asked to keep phones in their vehicles.

We ask that visits remain PG-13. Please no touching and sensor language.

Clients have the choice to receive visits.

Staff is available to support during family visits if concerns arise.

We are a non smoking campus. Visitors are asked to refrain from smoking while on campus.
