## St. Luke's University Health Network

Founded in 1872, [St. Luke's University Health Network](#) (SLUHN) is a fully integrated, regional, non-profit network providing services at 12 hospitals and 300+ outpatient sites. The Network's service area includes 11 counties: Lehigh, Northampton, Berks, Bucks, Carbon, Montgomery, Monroe, Schuylkill and Luzerne

counties in Pennsylvania and Warren and Hunterdon counties in New Jersey. St. Luke's is the preeminent teaching hospital in central-eastern Pennsylvania. In partnership with Temple University, St. Luke's created the Lehigh Valley's first and only regional medical school campus. It also operates the nation's longest continuously operating School of Nursing, established in 1884, and 38 fully accredited graduate medical educational programs with 347 residents and fellows. It is the only Lehigh Valley-based health care



system to earn Medicare's five- and four-star ratings (the highest) for quality, efficiency and patient satisfaction. It has earned the 100 Top Major Teaching Hospital designation from IBM Watson Health eight times total and six years in a row.
